

## Hereward Relay Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> November 2024 Useful “on the day” information

**ALL RUNNERS MUST WEAR A HI VIZ OVER THEIR CLUB VEST – your safety is very important – be safe and be seen.**

Team registration will take place at the start from 7:30am – Stage 1 runners must register prior to the race start.

**Ultra start time 8:30am    Relay start time 9:00am**

### **Peterborough – Start (PE1 5BW)**

Pay and display car park adjacent to the sports centre. Do not park in the sports centre as the gates will be locked soon after the race starts and will not reopen during the day.

Toilets in the sports centre.

### **Whittlesey – First handover (PE7 1UG) Aliwal Road**

There is plenty of car parking on the roads close to the handover, Station Road PE7 2HA. Please avoid parking in the sports centre as parking there is for members of the sports centre.

Toilets available in the sports centre.

### **March - second handover (PE15 9LS)**

Free car park in City Road adjacent to the playing field where the handover is located. Also roadside parking on Gaul Road from which, via The Chase, access to the playing field can be made.

Currently there are no public toilets in March however a number of establishments, pubs, coffee shops etc. will be open and have toilets for those who buy coffee etc. It may also be possible to use the toilets in the Leisure Centre but you will need to remove your shoes.

### **Welney – Third handover (PE14 9SD)**

Hand over adjacent to the Village Hall.

In order to remain safe from traffic runners and supporters must keep away from the access road as it is narrow.

There will be some car parking on the sports field. No parking is allowed in Hern Drove. Cars can also be parked in the village a short walk away from the handover. If you just wish to watch runners go through the village it is suggested that you avoid the handover area and park in the village itself and watch from there.

A limited range of refreshments including hot drinks and cake will be available at Welney.

Toilets will be available in the pavilion.

Additionally, the Lamb and Flag pub is located in the village and will be open should you wish for a beer, coffee or meal. The runners will run past the pub as they leave the village.

### **Ely – The finish (CB6 2SH)**

There is limited parking at the Rugby Club but ample parking for supporters in the Ely Leisure Village (adjacent to the finish – Post Code CB6 2SH) (near Arbuckles Restaurant, MacDonalds, Costa and KFC establishments) which is a short walk away – please DO NOT park in the Football and Golf Club Car Parks.

The bar will be open plus limited refreshments, changing facilities and toilets are available at the finish.
